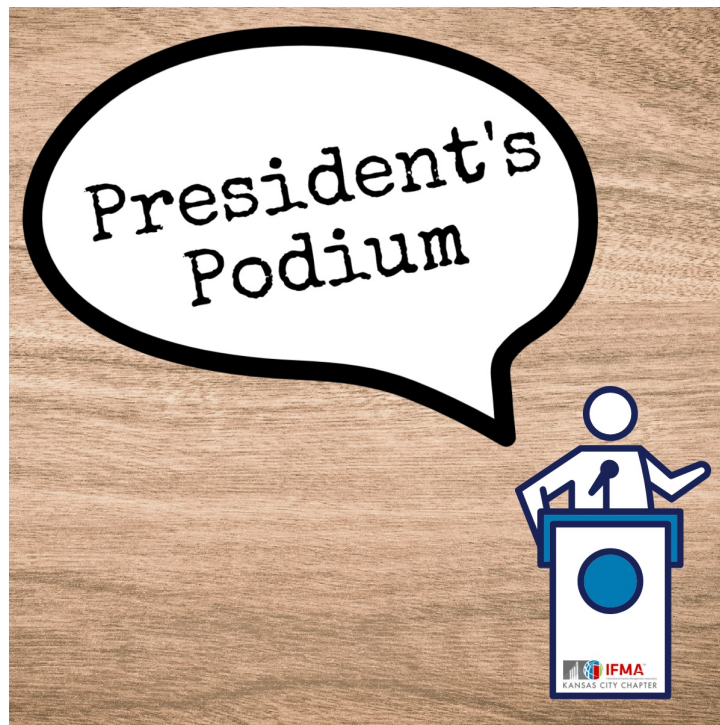


It's No Joke! Come for an egg-cellent event!
